

Example Visits for Primary Schools

30 Children – Half Day

Example 1

Number of Children: Up to 30

Duration of Visit: Any duration, any time of day (*Museum open 10am-5pm, 7 days a week*)

Cost: £2 per person

Venue: The Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum

ACTIVITY
Arrive at the Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum <i>(coach parking is available in the lay-by behind the Museum on Commercial Road)</i>
The group can visit the museum and wander the galleries to their heart's content! You can choose to give the children some gallery trail sheets, which will keep them busy for at least an hour, or have a more relaxed visit where the focus is on looking, seeing and speaking <i>(The Museum Gallery Trail sheets are available to download from the Museum website)</i>

Number of Children: Up to 30

Duration of Visit: 2 hours – either a morning / afternoon session

Cost: £4 per child

Venue: The Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum

09:45	Arrive at the Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum (<i>coach parking is available in the lay-by behind the Museum on Commercial Road</i>) Class split into two groups: Group 'A' and Group 'B'
10:00-11:00	Group A have taught session in the Regimental Boardroom, Group B have guided tour of Museum
11:00-12:00	Groups swap over for session / guided tour
OR	
AFTERNOON SESSION	
12:15	Arrive at the Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum Class split into two groups: Group 'A' and Group 'B'
12:30-13:30	Group A have taught session in Regimental Boardroom, Group B have guided tour of Museum
13:30-14:30	Groups swap over for session / guided tour

Schools choose whether to have lunch at school before they come, or arrive a bit earlier than the above stated times and have lunch on-site. The Museum doesn't have an inside space that will accommodate all 30 children at one time, but we do have use of a large hall within the Gloucestershire Academy of Music, located across the street. Number of Children: Up to 30

Duration of Visit: 09:30-14:20 (whole school day)

Cost: £6 per child for whole day (*minimum cost £180*)

Venue: The Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum

09:45-10:45	Group A have taught session in the Regimental Boardroom, Group B have guided tour of Museum
10:45-11:45	Groups swap over for session / guided tour
LUNCH BREAK	
11:45-12:15	School can choose how to spend lunch; 1. Sit outside on benches at the Soldiers Museum (<i>free</i>) 2. Use the indoor hall at the Gloucester Academy of Music (<i>free</i>) – (<i>located across the road from the Museum</i>)
AFTERNOON SESSION	
12:15	Arrive at the Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum Class split into two groups: Group 'A' and Group 'B'
12:20-13:20	Group A have a second taught session in the Regimental Boardroom, Group B meet and interview some Gloucestershire Regiment / Royal Gloucestershire Hussar Veterans
13:20-14:20	Groups swap over for second taught session / interview with Veterans

Duration of Visit: 09:15-14:20 (whole school day)

Cost: £6 per child for whole day (*an additional £4 per child for the boat trip if requested*)

Venues: The Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum and The National Waterways Museum Gloucester

10:30-11:30	Groups swap over for session / guided tour
LUNCH BREAK	
11:30-12:15	School can choose how to spend lunch; 3. Sit outside on benches at Soldiers Museum (<i>free</i>) 4. Use the indoor learning space at the Waterways Museum (<i>free</i>) 5. Eat lunch whilst on-board a 45 minute boat trip from the National Waterways Museum Gloucester (<i>Apr-Oct only, additional £4 per head</i>)
AFTERNOON SESSION	
12:15	Arrive at the National Waterways Museum Gloucester Class split into two groups: Group 'A' and Group 'B'
12:20-13:20	Group A have an educational workshop, Group B have a look around the Museum
13:20-14:20	Groups swap over for workshop / tour

Number of Children: Up to 30

Duration of Visit: 09:45-14:10 (whole school day)

Cost: £7.33 per child for whole day *(£4 per child for Museum sessions, £100 for GAMELAN workshop at the Gloucester Academy of Music – see below for details about bursaries)

Venues: The Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum and the Gloucester Academy of Music

09:45	Arrive at the Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum (<i>coach parking is available in the lay-by behind the Museum on Commercial Road</i>) Class split into two groups: Group 'A' and Group 'B'
10:00-11:00	Group A have taught session in Regimental Boardroom, Group B have guided tour of Museum
11:00-12:00	Groups swap over for session / guided tour
LUNCH BREAK	
12:00-12:30	School can choose how to spend lunch; 6. Sit outside on benches at Soldiers Museum (<i>free</i>) 7. Use the large hall within the Gloucester Academy of Music (<i>free</i>) 8. Eat lunch whilst on-board a 45 minute boat trip from the National Waterways Museum Gloucester (<i>Apr-Oct only, additional £4 per head</i>)
AFTERNOON SESSION	
12:35	Arrive at the Gloucestershire Academy of Music (<i>located across the road from the Museum</i>)
12:40-14:10	Whole class have a hands-on GAMELAN session (<i>can be offered for 1 hour or 1.5 hours if requested</i>)

*Bursaries are available from the Gloucester Academy of Music – if you have at least 30% Pupil Premium at your school you will be able to claim a bursary of £100 off your transport costs, and the GAMELAN workshop will reduce to only £30 in total.
