

Example Visits for Primary Schools

60 Children – Half Day

Example 1

Number of Children: Up to 60

Duration of Visit: Any duration, any time of day (*Museum open 10am-5pm, 7 days a week*)

Cost: £2 per person

Venue: The Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum

ACTIVITY
Arrive at the Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum <i>(coach parking is available in the lay-by behind the Museum on Commercial Road)</i>
The group can visit the museum and wander the galleries to their heart's content! You can choose to give the children some gallery trail sheets, which will keep them busy for at least an hour, or have a more relaxed visit where the focus is on looking, seeing and speaking <i>(The Museum Gallery Trail sheets are available to download from the Museum website)</i>

If you would like an inside space for the group to have lunch, please let us know and we can make sure this is available for you.

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Example 2

Number of Children: Up to 60

Duration of Visit: 2 hours – either a morning / afternoon session

Cost: £4 per child

Venue: The Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum and The National Waterways Museum Gloucester

09:15	Whole party split into two classes – Class ‘A’ and Class ‘B’ Class ‘A’ arrive at the Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum Class ‘B’ arrive at the National Waterways Museum Gloucester
09:30-10:30	Class ‘A’ do the gallery trail around the Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum Class ‘B’ do a workshop at the National Waterways Museum
10:30-10:40	Classes walk over to alternative site (<i>only a 2 minute walk</i>)
10:40	Class ‘A’ arrive at the National Waterways Museum Gloucester Class ‘B’ arrive at the Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum
10:45-11:45	Class ‘A’ do a workshop at the National Waterways Museum Class ‘B’ do the gallery trail around the Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum

Schools can choose whether to stay on and have lunch before they return to school, or to have lunch back at school. If a lunch space is required the following options are available;

LUNCH BREAK

Cost: £6 per child for whole day (*an additional £4 per child for the boat trip if requested*)

Venues: The Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum and The National Waterways Museum Gloucester

Duration of Visit: 09:45-14:10 (whole school day)

Cost: £7.33 per child for whole day *(£4 per child for Museum sessions, £100 for GAMELAN workshop at the Gloucester Academy of Music – see below for details about bursaries)

Venues: The Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum and the Gloucester Academy of Music

Eat lunch whilst on-board a 45 minute boat trip from the National Waterways Museum Gloucester <i>(Apr-Oct only, additional £4 per head)</i>
AFTERNOON SESSION	
12:30	Class ‘A’ and Class ‘B’ walk to alternative site <i>(only a 2 minute walk)</i>
12:35-14:05	Class ‘A’ have a 1.5 hour visit to the Gloucester Academy of Music <i>(a hands-on music workshop offered in a spacious hall)</i> Class ‘B’ have a 1.5 hour visit to the Soldiers of Gloucestershire Museum <i>(to include an hour’s taught session and a gallery trail around the museum)</i>

*Bursaries are available from the Gloucester Academy of Music – if you have at least 30% Pupil Premium at your school you will be able to claim a bursary of £100 off your transport costs, and the GAMELAN workshop will reduce to only £30 in total.
